श्रुता ग्रहगुणास्त्वत्तस्तथा राशिगुण मुने।
श्रोतमिच्छामि भावानां भेदांस्तान् कृपया वद ॥ १ ॥
śrutā grahaguṇāstvattastathā rāśiguṇa mune |
śrotamicchāmi bhāvānāṁ bhedāṁstān kṛpayā vada || 1||
Maitreya prays to Parāśara as “Muni” – recall Kṛta
Chandas Mantra in Year-1
ॐ नमः मुनिश्रेष्ठाय त्रिकालज्ञाय पराशराय स्वाहा।
om namaḥ muṇiśreṣṭhāya trikālajñāya parāśarāya svāhā|
Have heard [upadeśa is always heard, 11H, 3H]
Graha-guṇa-stva-ttas-tathā rāśi-guṇa
we now DESIRE to hear “bhāva bheda” – kindly speak
(vada).
वद vada = वेद veda
vedamātā mantra is required for bhāva bheda



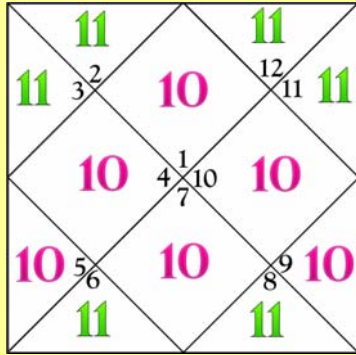

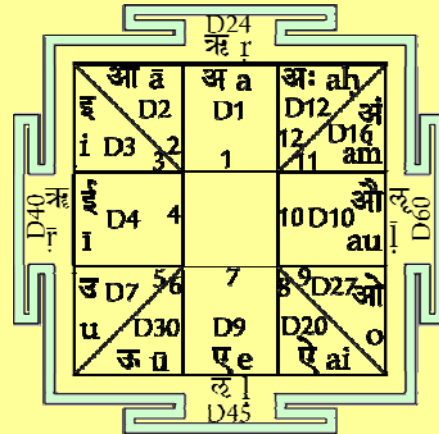

 om virāṭ cchandaṣe namaḥ
 ॐ वाग्देवतायै नमः ← Heart
 om vāgdevatāyai namaḥ
 ॐ ऐं बीजाय नमः ← Private
 om aiṁ bījāya namaḥ
 ॐ स्वाहा शक्तये नमः [10] ← Feet
 om svāhā śaktaye namaḥ
 ॐ ह्रीं शक्तये नमः [11]
 om hrīm śaktaye namaḥ



Sixteen Sanskrit Vowels

1. Soul (Sun) manifests in sixteen (ṣoḍaśa) ways
2. These sixteen ways are represented by the sixteen vowels of Sanskrit
3. For this continuity Śaktī takes the form of Ṣoḍaśī (Tripura Sundarī)

Veda-**vā**hvarṇśa D24 = Carrier of the Veda, Ṛṣi, Guru, Vyāsa Kha m.

1. a cavity, hollow, cave , cavern, aperture
2. an aperture of the human body {of which there are nine – (1) mouth, (2,3) two ears, (4,5) two eyes, (6,7) two nostrils, organs of (8) excretion and (9) generation}
3. empty space, air, ether, sky
4. heaven
5. the tenth house

Akṣa – indestructible, undefeated, diamond, thunderbolt; beads of rosary (carrier of mantra)

Samjñā – clear knowledge, perfect communication, acknowledge, recognize
